MAULANA AZAD NATIONAL URDU UNIVERSITY

Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) is a Central University established in 1998 by an Act of Parliament to promote and develop Urdu language and to improve vocational and technical education in Urdu medium through regular and distance modes. The headquarters of the University is at an outstanding location – Gachibowli, Hyderabad, spread over 200 acres. The students and the staff of the University are drawn from across the country. They are attracted by the commitment to excellence in quality education in various disciplines of knowledge. It has been accredited 'A+' grade by NAAC.

The mandate of the University includes promotion and development of Urdu language and education of women.

The University presently comprises of seven schools of studies namely: 1) School of Language, Linguistics & Indology, 2) School of Commerce and Business Management, 3) School of Education & Training, 4) School of Journalism & Mass Communication, 5) School of Arts & Social Sciences and 6) School of Sciences, 7) School of Computer Sciences & Information Technology, 8) MANUU Law School. These 8 schools run 23 departments and 9 centers. In addition to offering master's programs, many of these departments provide research programs at M. Phil and Ph.D. level. The focus of all these schools is to promote new areas of learning and advance knowledge through research and application.

MANUU CSE RCA

Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Civil Services Examinations, Residential Coaching Academy (MANUU CSE RCA) was established in 2009 for minorities and women. The objective of the Academy is to provide coaching and guidance to the women and religious minorities to enable them to join the All-India Services. The Academy has its own newly constructed premises in the MANUU Campus, with air-conditioned class rooms, an Auditorium Audio Visual and Wi-Fi facilities. Auditorium has digital screen for clarity and absorbability of the learning material by the students. The Academy also has a well-stocked Library and reading room. All the students admitted to the Academy are provided with hostel facilities.

Expert faculty is also outsourced to impart coaching to the aspirants for different subjects.

ADVISORY COMMITTEE

MANUU CSE RCA has an Advisory Committee under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor of the University which formulates the academic programs and gives advice and guidance on matters related to the academic affairs of the Academy. The Committee comprises retired and serving officers of IAS, IPS, IRS, educationists and Trainers. Internal complaints committee.

COACHING PROGRAMME

The Academy offers coaching for all the three phases of the UPSC Civil Services Examination, namely:

- **Preliminary Test**
- **Main Examination (Written)**
- **Interview (Personality Test)**

COACHING MODULES

Coaching Modules offered at MANUU CSE RCA are designed to suit the three phased scheme of the Civil Services Examination conducted by the UPSC. Three different modules have been worked out: 1) Prelims, 2) Mains and 3) Personality Test (Interview).

1) Prelims 2026: In this module focused coaching will be given for the Preliminary Examination. The coaching is for about 8 months. Attendance in Test Series for Prelims exam of UPSC CSE is mandatory. Absence in tests may result in cancellation of candidature of aspirants. Special Sessions of Toppers are also conducted time to time. The admission into this module is based on the Entrance Test conducted by MANUU CSE RCA.

2) Mains 2025 and Mains 2026: It is a short-term coaching module of about 13 weeks. Under this module coaching and guidance will be given for the Main Examination for the compulsory GS papers, excluding papers on proficiency in English and Indian language, will be dealt with. The admission into this module is based on the Interview conducted by MANUU CSE RCA. Those who clear Preliminary Exam of UPSC CSE can contact above officials for admission process. Nominal fee for admission will be charged.

3) Personality Test 2025 and 2026: It is about one month duration, targeted towards those who have been called for Personality Test by UPSC. Mock Interviews, inviting experts from different fields to guide the students will be arranged. Guidance will be given on how to conduct oneself during the personality test. Only nominal registration fee will be charged for admission into this module.

Note: The dates of notification, commencement and duration of coaching will be as per the schedule and is liable for alternation, if the circumstances so warrant.

The students are required to keep themselves abreast of the Important Dates for the UPSC Civil Services Examination, 2026.

As notified the UPSC will issue notification in the month of February 2026. The Preliminary Exam will be held in the month of May 2026 and the Mains Exam will be held in the month of August, at different centers throughout the country.

ENTRANCE TEST

The basic pattern of the Entrance Test of the Academy is similar to that of UPSC Preliminary Examination. In addition, there will be one Essay on the lines of Paper I, Essay, of UPSC Main Examination. Essay has to be written in English. However, those who intend to write UPSC Main Examination in Hindi or Telugu or Urdu can write the essay in that language.

Scheme: The Entrance Test will be of 200 marks(Multiple Choice). Section I will have 100 questions each carrying 2 marks (100x2=200 marks).

Candidates have to mark their responses in the OMR sheet. The total duration of the Entrance Test will be of two hours. The minimum cut off marks will be 25% in the entrance test. Short-listed aspirants will be called for interview carrying 50 marks. Interview will be at MANUU Campus, Hyderabad.

Entrance test qualified candidates called for Personality Test have to write, essay writing test which will be conducted prior to the Personality Test on the same day. Essay will be carrying 100 marks.

Final selection will be on merit, based on combined marks obtained in Entrance Test and Interview.

INFRASTRUCTURE & FACILITIES

Library: Library is a prerequisite for any academic activity, more so, if it is competition oriented. Realizing this MANUU CSE RCA has set-up its own library. Text books, Reference books, Journals, Magazines and Newspapers in English, Telugu and Urdu etc. are stocked in accordance with needs of the aspirants. Aspirants can also avail, the facilities of the University Central Library.

Hostel: Comfortable stay of the aspirants is ensured. Boys' and girls' hostel are separate and are situated in the MANUU Campus. Mess charges based on the actual spent on food as fixed by the authorities has to be borne by the aspirant and paid directly to the concerned mess Committee. A nominal fee is collected for lodging as decided by the University.

Other: As the MANUU CSE RCA is situated in the campus, the aspirants can also use all the facilities that are available at campus such as the gym, playgrounds etc.

FEE PARTICULARS

The fee structure of MANUU CSE RCA for its different coaching modules is as under:

*Mess charges are charged separately per month as per facilities provided.

Stipend: 20% of the enrolled aspirants will be given stipend of Rs. 2,000/- per month on the basis of merit cum means, regularity and discipline, as decided by the Board/Committee setup for the purpose. To claim the stipend on means basis, the aspirants must get original certificates of income of their Guardians from the competent authorities.

***Candidates must ensure that they possess Bank account in their own name to get the benefits.**

RULES FOR THE ASPIRANTS

1. Hostel and mess related jurisdiction solely lies with hostel provost and their administration.
2. If anyone remains absent for more than 15 days without any valid reason duly approved by Director I/c; their admission will be canceled. And all security deposit shall be forfeited
3. **No refund of fees will be entertained after 15 days of admission.**
4. Class attendance and attending tests are mandatory. Attendance review will be undertaken every month. If the attendance of any candidate is less than 75%, s/he will be expelled from RCA forfeiting his/her any security money.
5. A high standard of discipline is expected from candidates all the time in campus. No group altercation or scuffles will be tolerated in addition to the university guidelines.
6. Original documents are mandatory to submit during admission. No admission will be allowed without original documents in any case.
7. During coaching session, if any candidate is found indulging in indiscipline or lack of interest for UPSC civil services exam preparation. Their hostel accommodation will be canceled.
8. In case of vacancies, Administration may give admission to candidates of high interest or capacity to clear exam only after taking mid-session test and interview after the approval of the director.
9. Hostel accommodation will be provided to only those candidates who desire to take classes and attend mandatory tests during the session. Those who only seek to study in library without involving in academic activities in RCA will be given admission only on day scholar basis.
10. Candidates cannot pursue any other courses in other universities/institutions of any type during the course of session.

11. Aspirants have to stay in the hostels of the Academy during the entire course. They have to abide by the existing rules and regulations as may be notified by university and the Academy from time to time.
12. Aspirants cannot leave the coaching in the middle of the course. If an aspirant leaves the academy in the middle, he/she will lose his/her caution deposit.
13. Aspirants should follow the procedure for taking leave for genuine reasons through the prescribed format of hostel mess attested by the CSERCA Faculty.
14. Aspirants should inform two days before taking leave.
15. The aspirants should carry their Identity Card with them at all times and they have to produce it before the concerned authority on demand.
16. The aspirants have to protect the property of the Academy and hostel in particular and MANUU in general. The aspirants responsible for the loss or damage to any property will have to compensate the loss.
17. Registration fee and other charges collected from the aspirants, other than the Caution deposit money is not refundable.
18. No aspirant can continue in the Academy for more than the period prescribed.
19. Aspirants taking admission in MANUU CSE RCA have to deposit attested copies of SSC, Intermediate and graduation Certificates with the office.
20. At the admission process they must bring their original certificates for verification. The originals will also be deposited with Academy and returned to the aspirant after Prelims examination.
21. They must also get health certificate from appropriate medical authorities.
22. Candidates cannot pursue any other courses in other universities/ institutions of any type during the course of session.

Fee and Deposit:

1. In case of expulsion of the aspirant from the Academy on disciplinary grounds or any other reason the caution deposit shall be forfeited.
2. The caution deposit is refunded only after the completion of the coaching. The aspirant has to submit an application with a no dues certificate from the hostel, mess and library to the Academy at the time of leaving the Academy.
3. Beyond one year after the completion of the coaching programmed the caution money shall be forfeited.
4. No money shall be forfeited before the completion of course.

Library:

1. Aspirants have to follow the library rules strictly. Library is a place of academic activity; social activities will not be permitted. Eating/discussions inside the library are not permitted.
2. Aspirants proceeding on leave for more than three days have to return their books borrowed from the library. They can borrow again after their return.

Attendance:

1. 75% Attendance in the classrooms is compulsory. Aspirants have to mark their attendance in the register regularly.
2. The aspirants have to appear for at all the Tests/Exams conducted by the Academy during the course of study.

Discipline:

1. The aspirants are not permitted to move or loiter in the MANUU Campus unnecessarily.
2. Aspirants cannot leave the Academy or Campus without permission of the Director or informing the office in writing.
3. The aspirants are expected to behave decently and courteously with others not only with aspirants in classrooms, hostel & outside, but also with the staff and the students of the university.

4. The aspirants cannot use their laptops, mobiles and any other electronic device in the classrooms, except with the permission of coordinator or authorities.
5. Watching movies/listening to music/smoking, drinking liquor in the hostel rooms and campus premises is strictly prohibited. In case of violation aspirants involved will be expelled from the hostel immediately.
6. Aspirants are not permitted to move tangible or intangible goods from the academy premises.
7. Aspirants are not allowed to bring their personal furniture in the Academy premises.

Hostel:

1. The hostel facility cannot be used for the stay of any relative or friend of the boarder. In case of such incidents being reported or observed disciplinary action will be taken against the particular boarder.
2. The Aspirants are responsible for the payment of their food and mess charges individually to the mess authorities and comply with all the requirements and regulations.
3. The aspirants have to vacate the hostel immediately after the completion of their coaching or whenever long holidays are declared.
4. Aspirants going to their homes must surrender the key of the room to the academy before leaving.
5. Mess bills must be paid on monthly basis promptly otherwise mess facilities will not be provided to defaulters.
6. The boarders shall use water and electricity facilities economically and not waste these facilities
